"Take One" youth mentorship pilot film program, presented by *The Philadelphia Film Factory* (Philm Factory) in partnership with *We Embrace Fatherhood*, provides local youth with various educational opportunities to gain empirical film experience, training, exposure, and other creative opportunities. Filmmaking is such a dynamic field because not only does it include being creative, but it involves life skills such as critical thinking, decision making, communication and leadership skills,

mathematics and budgeting, strategizing and team building. Additionally, our youth participants will have the opportunity to build their public speaking skills and learn to be solution-driven when challenges arise. Afterall, filmmaking is all about working with multi-functional teams and problem solving to create the finished product: **a film!** Youth participants will be paired with mentors and teams for the sole purpose of working together to create one collaborative short film at the end of the 7 weeks. Each participant will be invited to reunite with us at the red carpet screening and celebration in July.

The Philm Factory provides local independent filmmakers, residents and youth with various educational and economical opportunities to gain film experience and training. This is done through our training, programming, classes, workshops, events, projects, performances, festivals, and field trips. The Philm Factory, started as a film initiative provided by *Eli Lu Entertainment* but has grown to standing on its own as a 501C3 NonProfit to better serve and reach more of the local film community members. The "Take One": youth mentorship program is our first pilot youth film initiative.
